ENROLLMENT, grades 6-12:
525 students in 7 grades $=75$ average/grade
Assuming the 75 seats in each grade are equally available to each school, the following enrollment adjustments have been included:

- Chippens Hill, -56 students
- Northeast MS, -56 students
- Greene-Hills, -56 students
- West Bristol, -56 students
- Central HS, -150 students
- Eastern HS, - 150 students
- Arts Magnet, +525 students

## NEXT STEPS

1. Board of Ed and Board of Finance approval of Option 4
2. Consider bonding scenarios and timelines, include Arts Magnet
3. Adopt a Masterplan to complete the 3 projects in Option 4

More phasing details, useful in presentations to both state and to city residents
4. Submit ED049 to state for phase 1

6. Gather data, conduct testing, start phase 1 schematic design

## TWO HIGH SCHOOLS

Since the two high schools are experiencing declining enrollments, is there an opportunity to close one of them?

Projected Enrollments, including reductions for Magnet School effects:
Each High School will have approximately 150 students less, as students attend the Arts Magnet School.
Both schools are near their capacity now, but even with the projected drop in enrollments, neither school is large enough to take all of Bristol's high school students.


CENTRAL HIGH SCHOOL Pros:

- Newer building
- In better shape
- More efficient building layout

Cons:

- Smaller site
- Minimal buffers to neighboring houses
- Building addition more difficult
- Traffic problems


## EASTERN HIGH SCHOOL

## Pros:

- Larger site
- Building addition more feasible
- Closer to concentration of population

Cons:

- Older building
- More worn building
- Main office doesn'† control entrance
- More inefficient building layout
- Traffic problems

Either building would need a sizable addition to become the only high school, and additional parking. This would squeeze the site, eliminating some athletic fields.

Neither school has an overwhelming reason to be chosen as the only high school for Bristol.
